Question of: Modern Slavery

Keeping in mind that slavery is an illegal activity which takes away basic human rights and oppresses the free will of humans and is officially banned by all countries.

Noting with deep concern that slavery, especially in forms of sex trafficking, domestic servitude, factory and farm slavery and child soldier slavery, is the fastest growing criminal industry in the world.

Stressing that modern slavery is a hidden but widespread problem which has to be tackled forcefully.

Contemplating that still twenty-seven million of women, men and children are forced to work as slaves in our modern and civilized world.

1) Calls upon the UN to fight against slavery by:

- a) supporting the present organizations who search hidden places where humans are still enforced workers.
- b) creating a fund to raise money to improve law enforcement, for example by building up special forces on human trafficking, and strengthen information exchange between law enforcement agencies on international trafficking routes and traffickers' profiles in order to dismantle criminal groups.
- c) raising awareness through public education
- d) recalling for a strict persecution of human traffickers and their assistance

2) Recommends human traffickers get a reasonable time of prison to be set individually by each UN- member state.

3) Proposes the UN to develop educational material to clarify the consequences and interactions resulting from the slave trade.

4) Calls upon the industrialized countries to avoid buying child slavery products.

5) Emphasizes every country to sign a treaty of human rights to ensure the abolishing of modern slavery.
